Our Goal

In South Sudan (SSD) we aim to improve the quality of life and resilience of vulnerable communities through comprehensive integrated, environmentally and gender sensitive interventions in health and well-being including livelihoods, and emergency preparedness and response.

Johanniter International Assistance has been active in South Sudan since 2012. We operate in two states, with field offices in Wau and a satellite office in Raja, both located in Western Bahr el Ghazal in the western part of the country, and in Torit, Eastern Equatoria, in the northeast.

South Sudan continues to face one of the world's most complex humanitarian crises. According to the UNOCHA, an estimated 9.9 million people across the country are in need of humanitarian assistance, with 4.3 million targeted for aid delivery. The impact on resources and services are also stretched by the influx of 525,000 Returnees and 602,000 Refugees amongst which 572,000 are Sudanese, according to the South Sudan Country Refugee Response Plan (CRRP) 2026.

What we want to achieve

We are committed to attaining this through implementation of integrated projects incorporating health service and well-being, WASH, Food Security & Livelihoods (FSL), Nutrition, Protection (GBV) and Emergency Response.

From an organizational perspective, we commit to fulfill our two Organizational Objectives of Quality & Accountability and Growth & Engagement through improvements on our processes and procedures of conducting business and rigorously engaging with our existing and new donors for fundraising.

Health

We focus mainly on children under-five (U5) years, pregnant and lactating women. Johanniter provides treatment of under-fives (U5) through community engagement as well as improving access to Sexual and Reproductive Health (SRH) services through community case management in hard-to-reach areas as well as construction and equipping of maternity wards. The overall objective is to improve the quality of lives and well-being of the vulnerable communities; thus, we are implementing an integrated approach to programming that aims to respond to health, WASH, FSL, protection and nutrition needs in target communities.

Emergency response

Johanniter supports the communities affected by disasters or conflicts to survive and return to a safe and dignified life as well as build on their resilience and capacity to minimize the impact of shocks from such calamities.

Johanniter SSD also focuses on climate change and gender as the core topics to be addressed across the strategic programmatic objectives and in its internal processes and systems.
